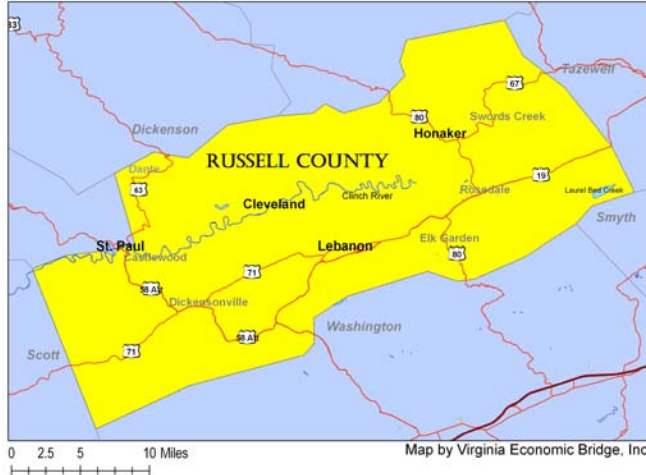

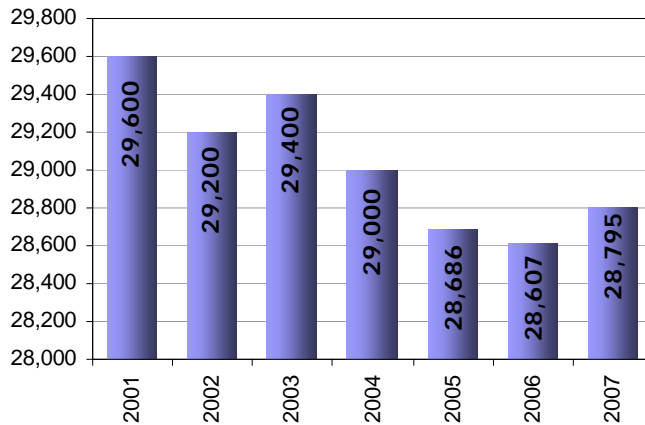

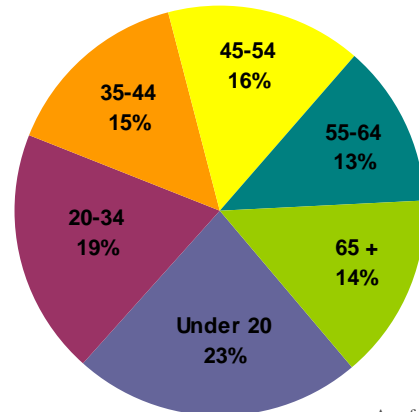

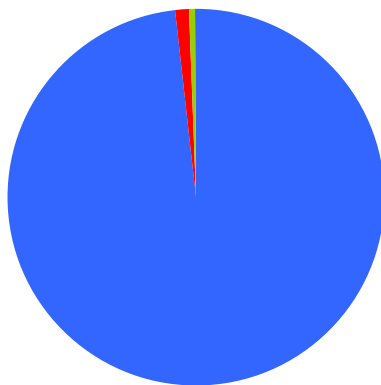


### Population by Age

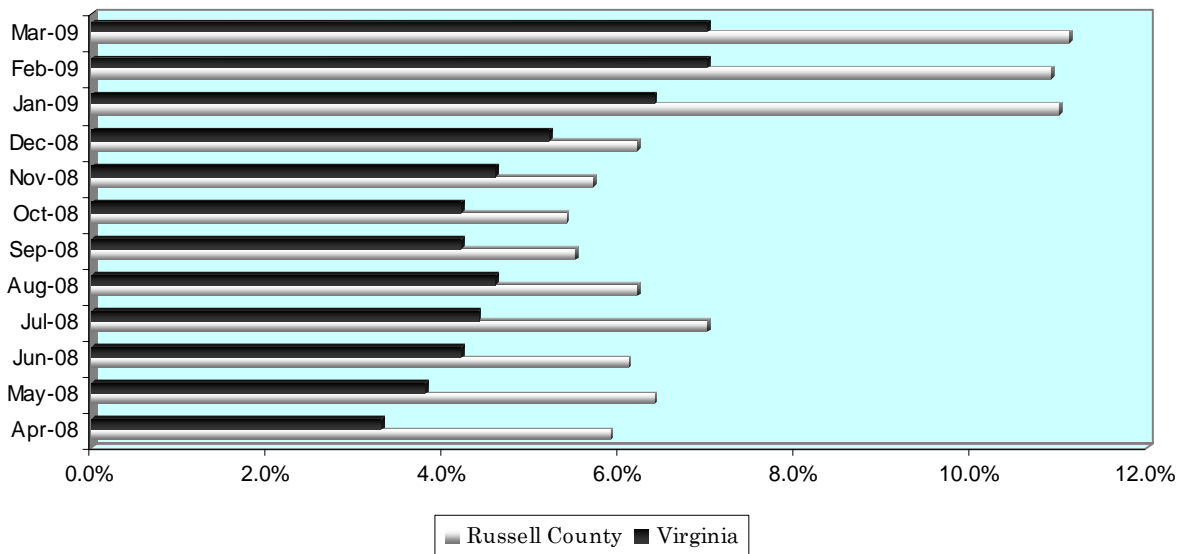

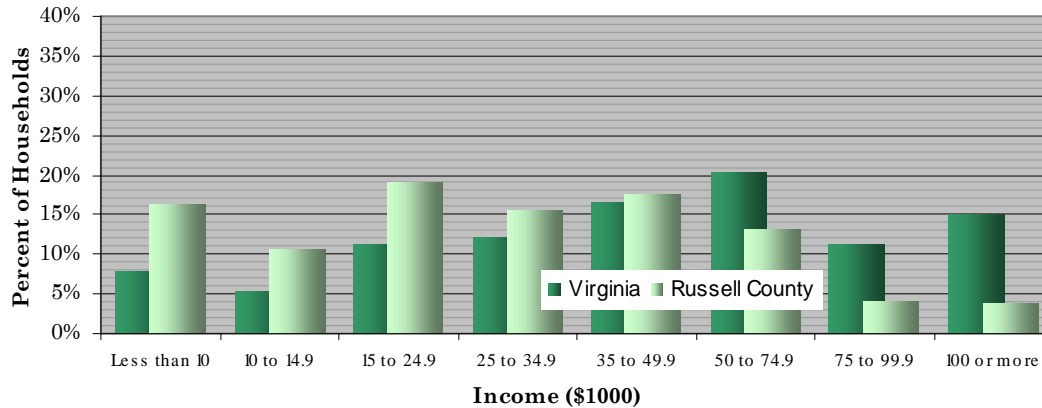
