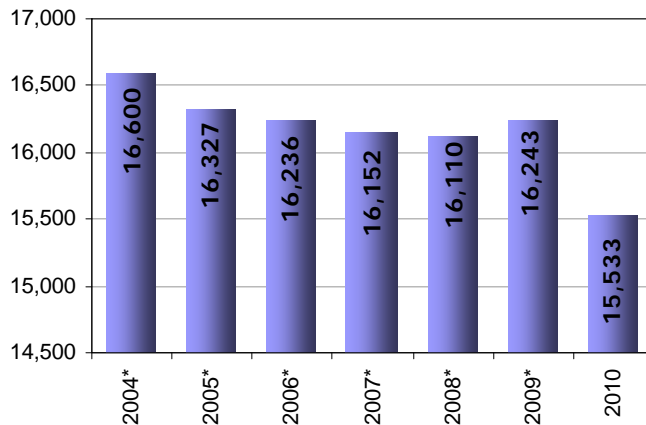

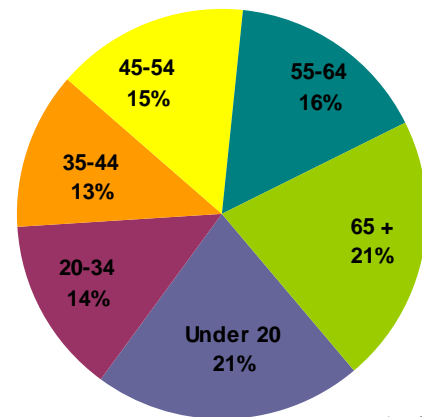

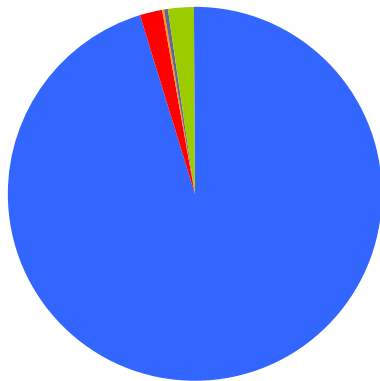


Population by Age

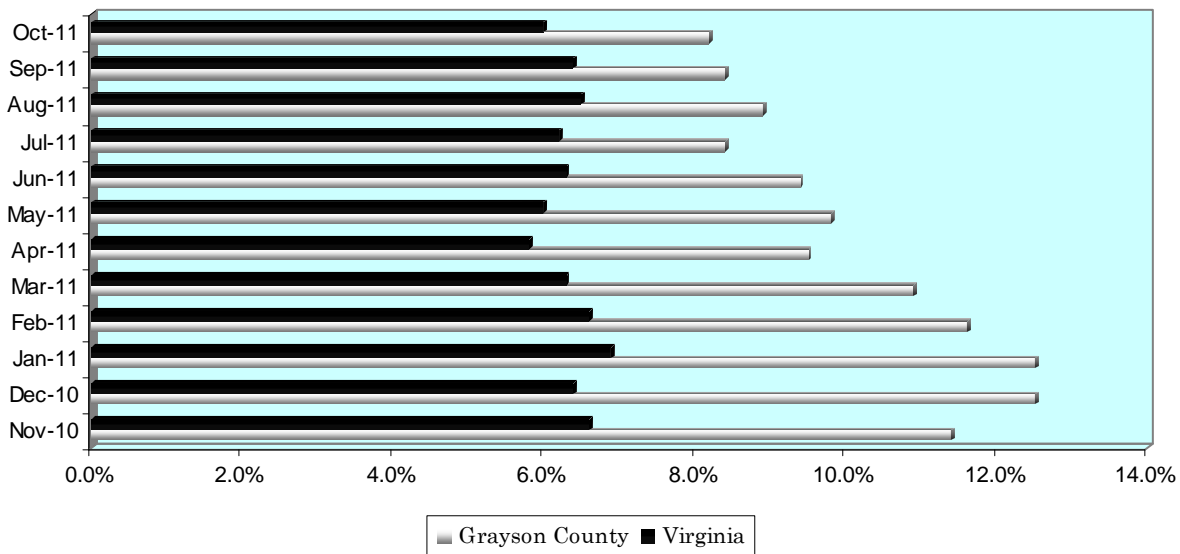

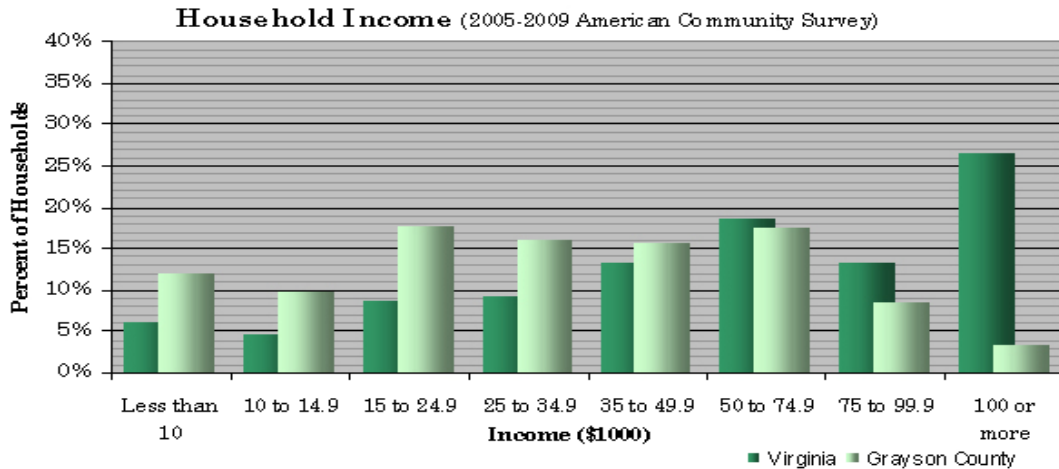
