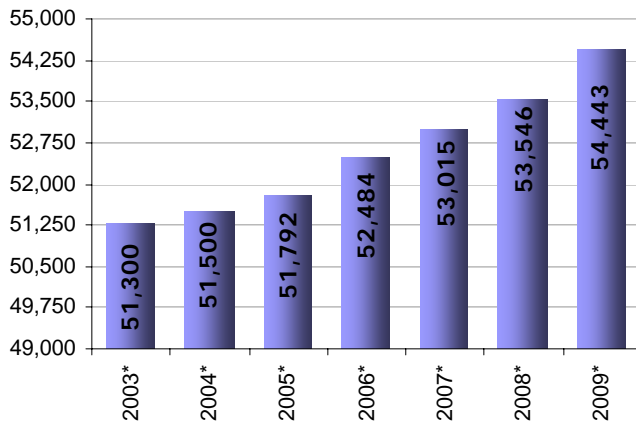

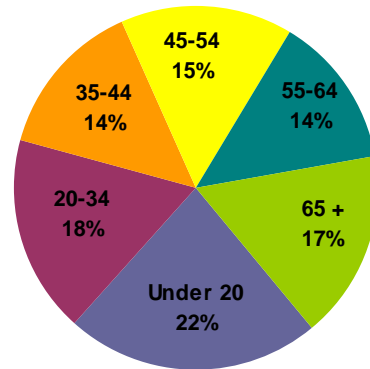

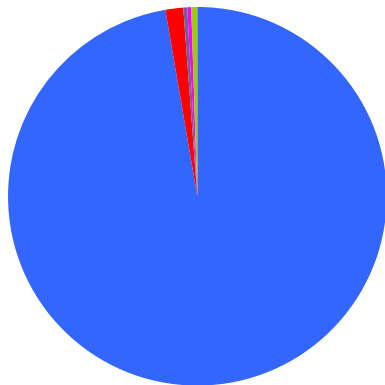


### Population by Age

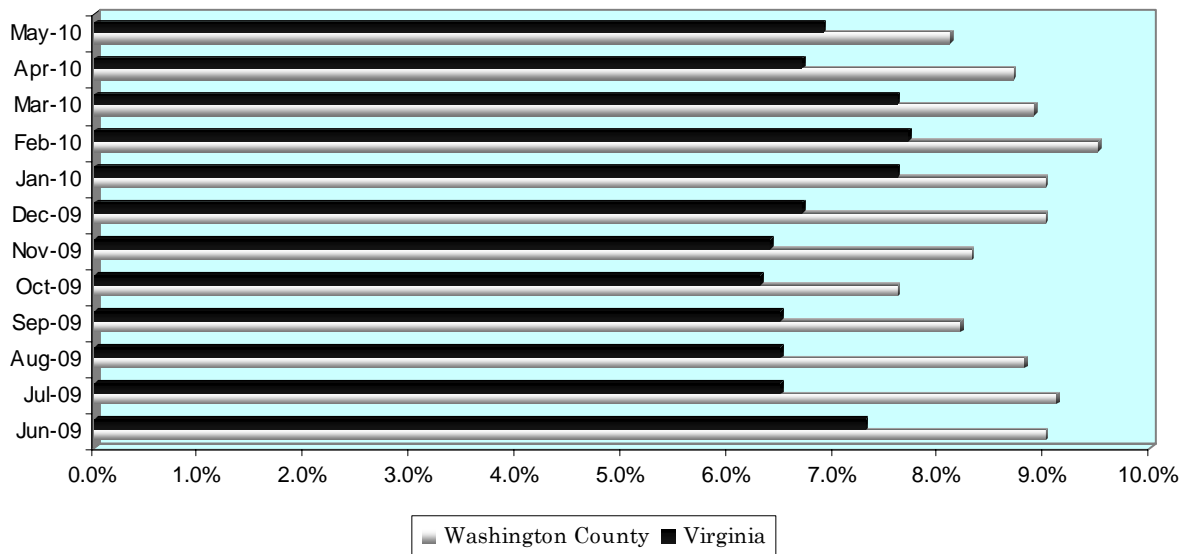

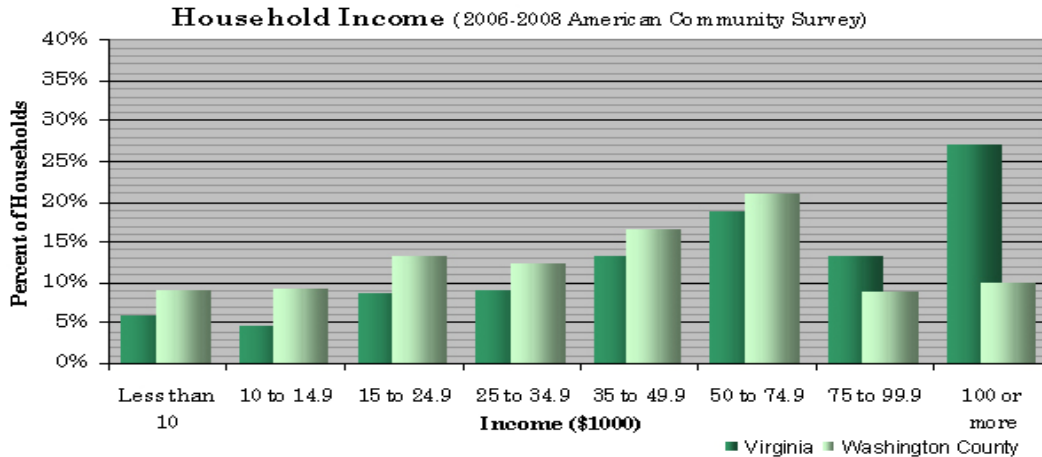
