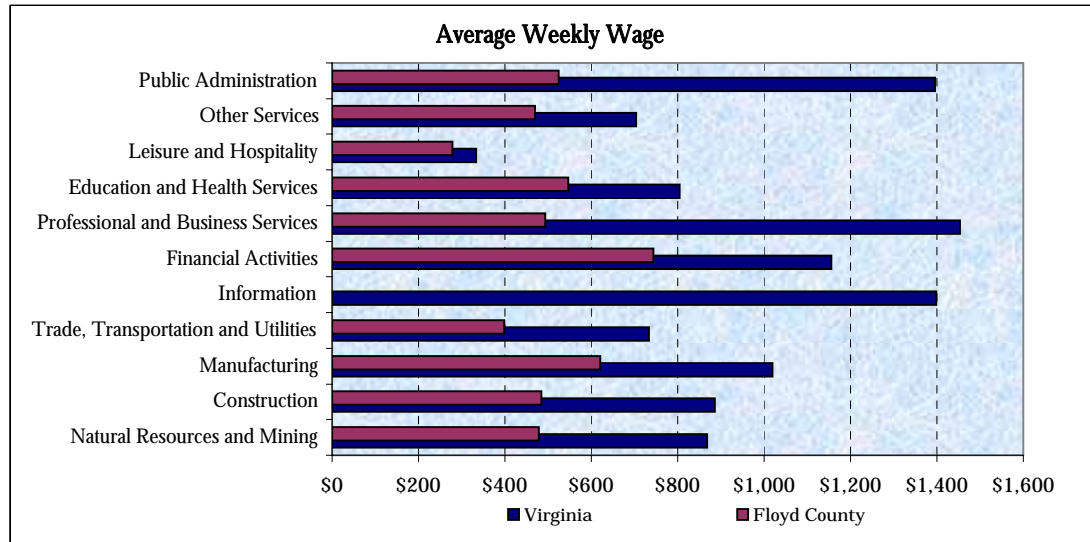


## Average Weekly Wage by Sector
