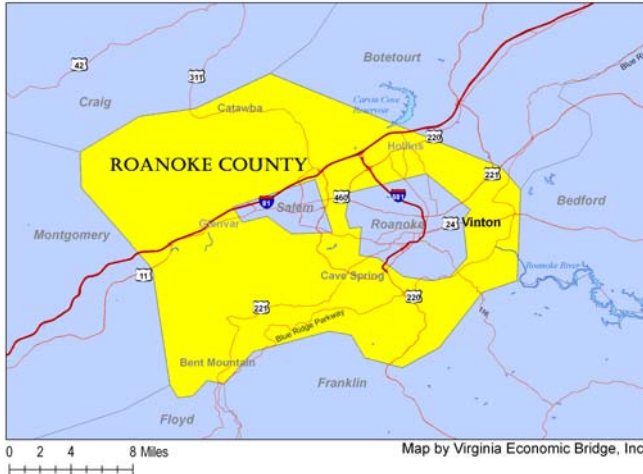

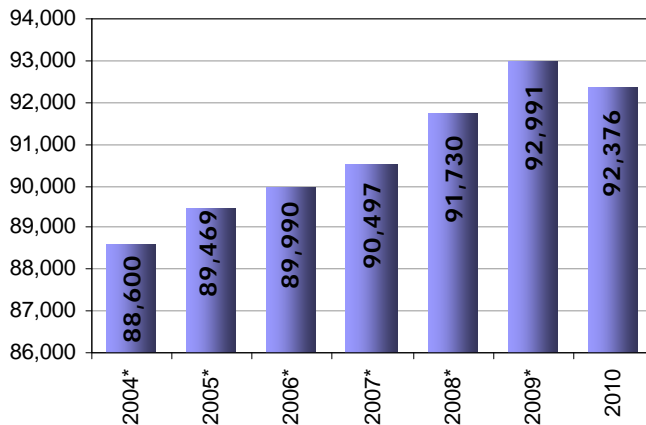

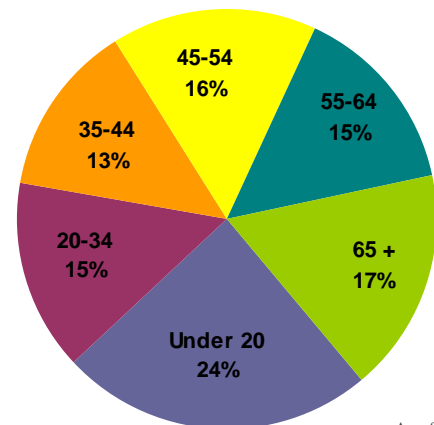

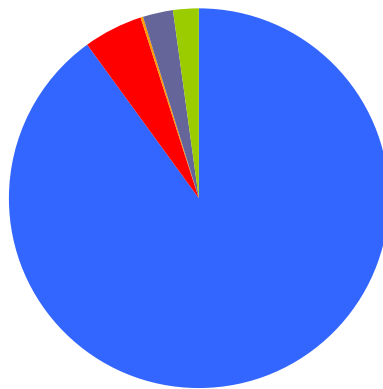


**Population by Age**

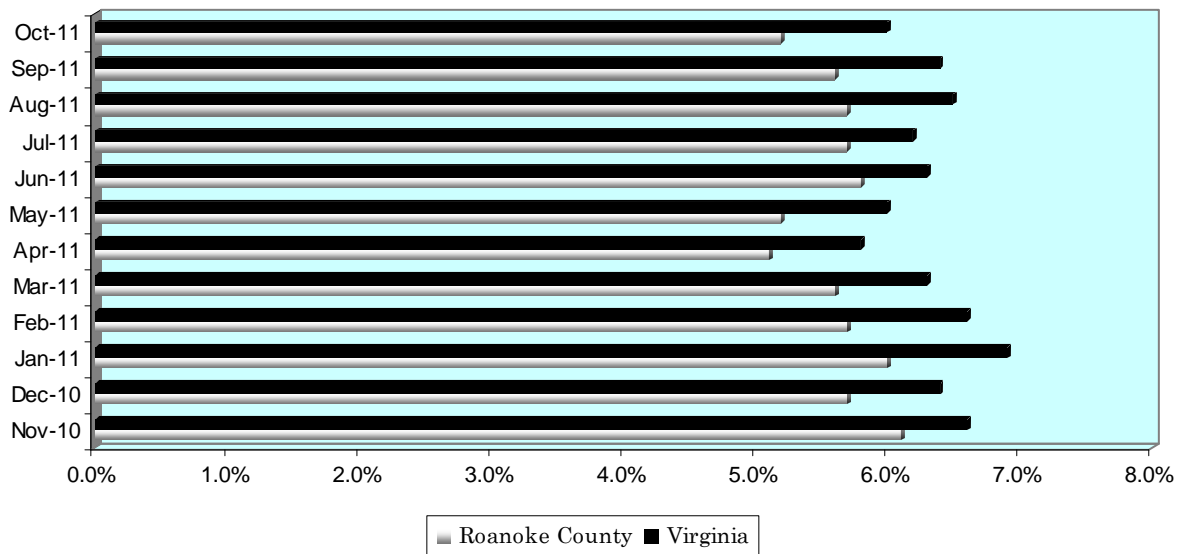

### UNEMPLOYMENT RATE: November '10 – October '11



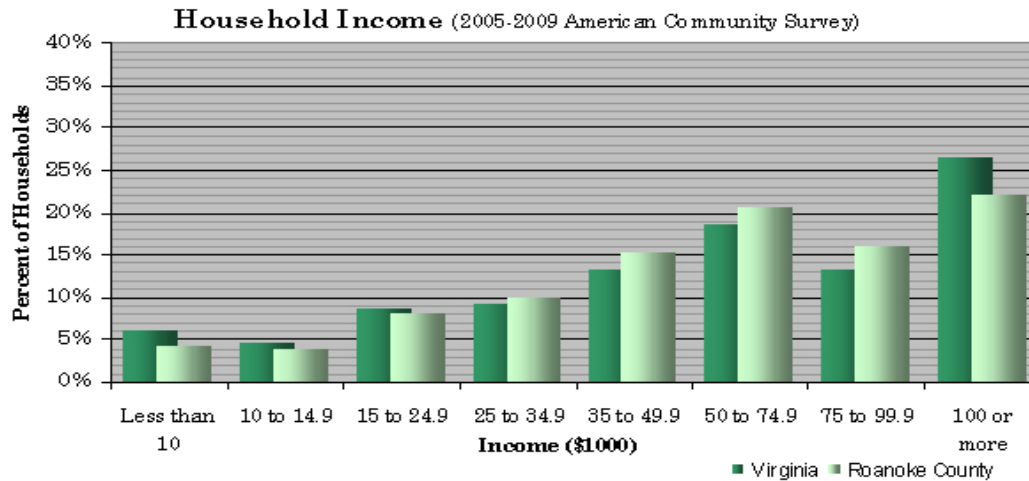
