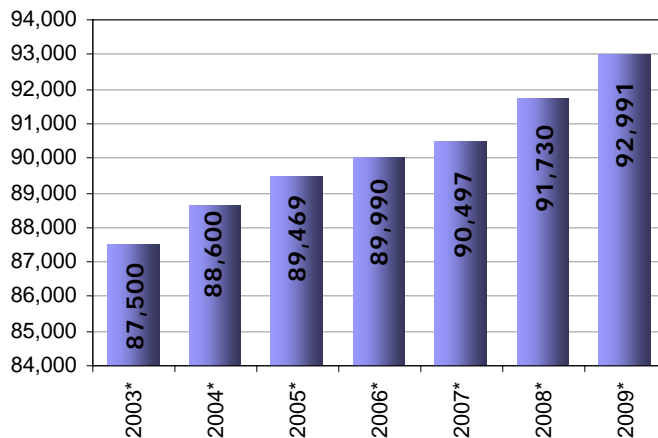

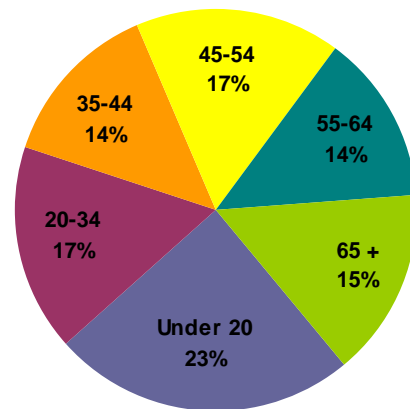

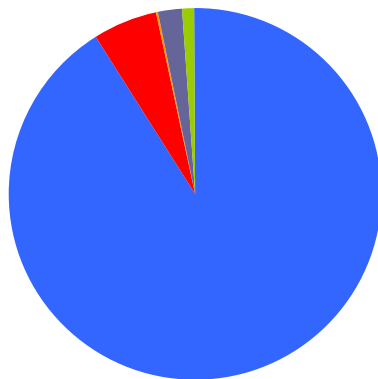


Population by Age

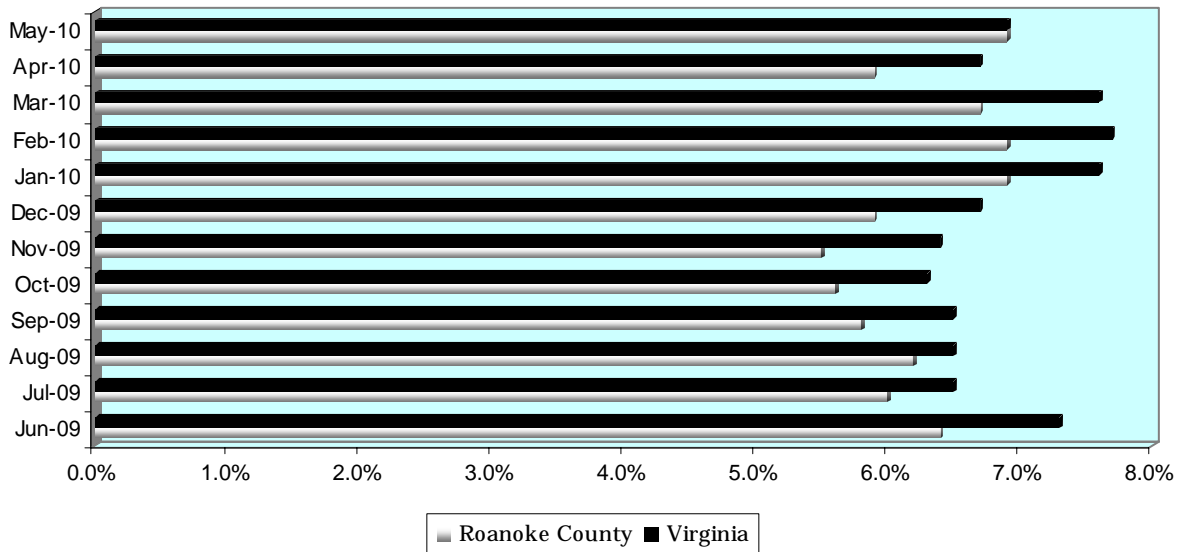

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE: June '09 -- May '10



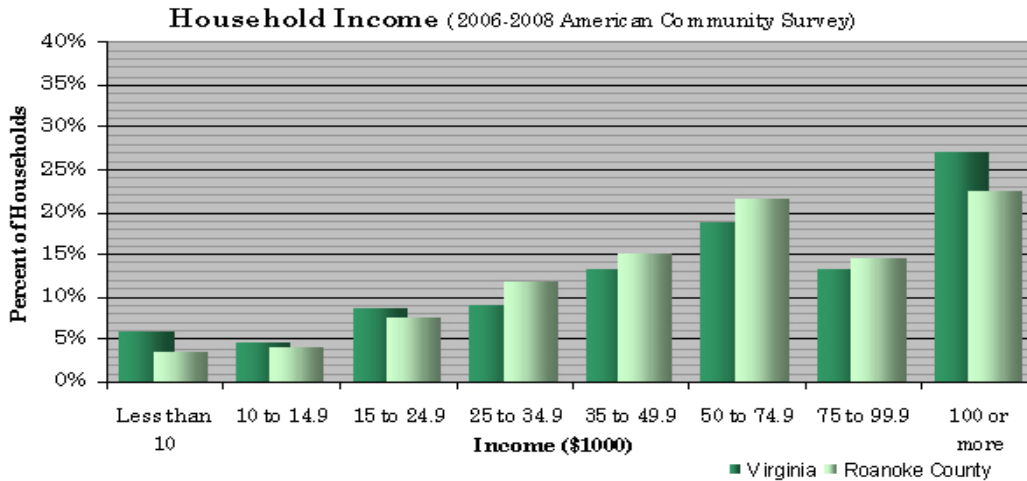
