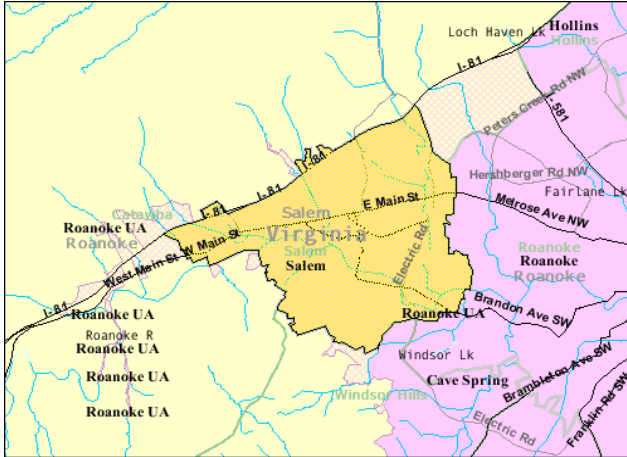

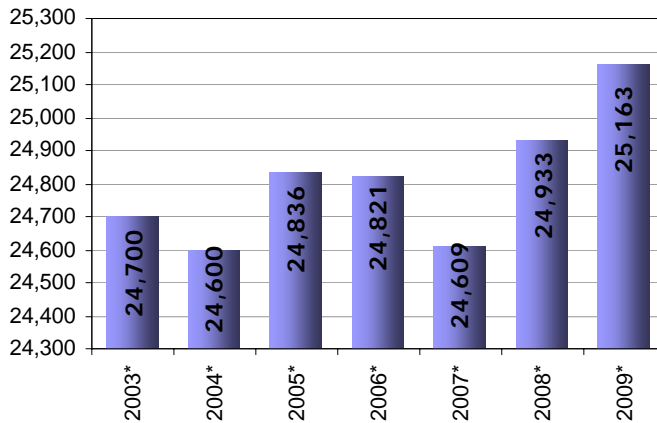

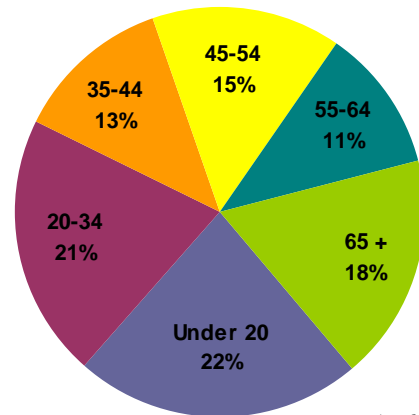

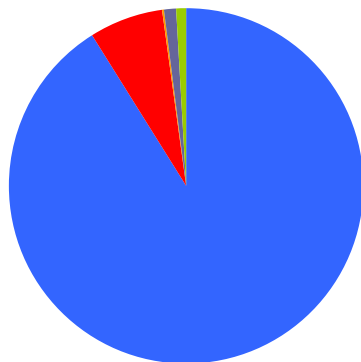


Population by Age

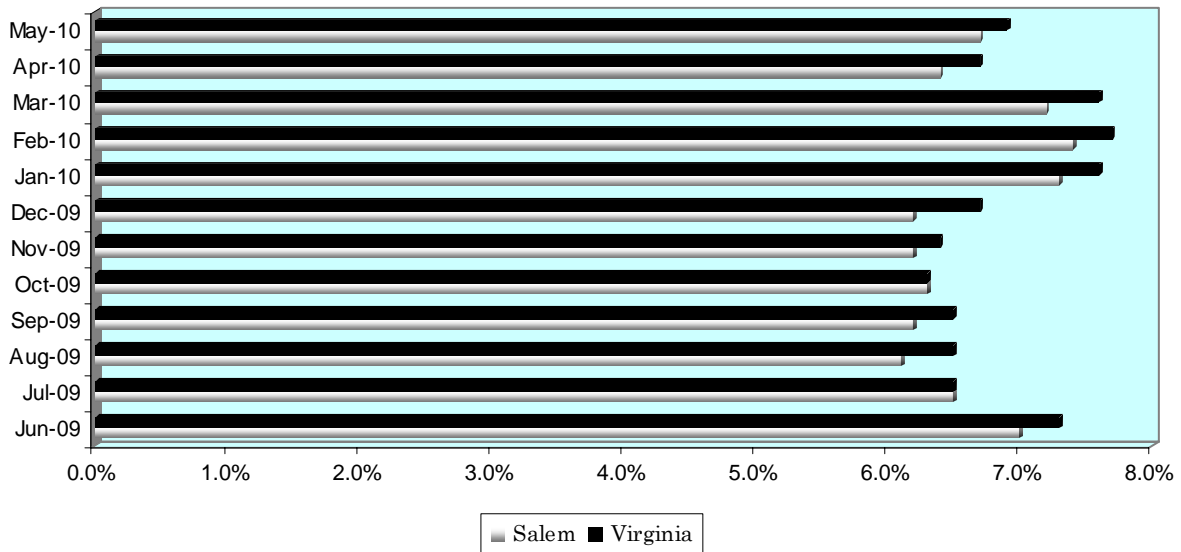

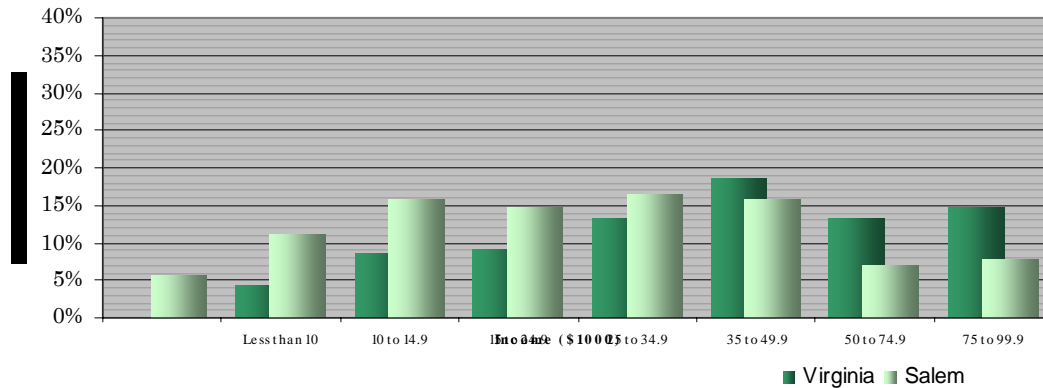
